Writing from Dark Spaces – In the setting of the dramatic dark-panelled Tudor Hall discover the origins of flint and its influence on our landscape. Handle ancient flints and explore the histories they contain, mining and knapping words along the way.

Hard Lives – Stories from the Flint Face – Take inspiration from the surprising life stories of those who worked with flint in Brandon's industrial heyday. From flint walls to flintlocks and flint jewellery, this ancient material still sparkles with relevance.
